At 900, it's looking pretty good for it's age, so no wonder Angkor Wat's pinecone-shaped towers and ornate bas-reliefs are still the stuff of bucket-list dreams. Having gone all that way, you won't want baseball caps and selfie sticks intruding on your perfect snap. Enter About Asia's new tours: timed to avoid the busiest hours, they'll steer you behind the scenes on special-access visits led by archaeologists. Take a photography tour at sunrise, breakfast beside a lesser-known temple and sip sunset drinks on the moat of Angkor Thom. A five-day trip staying infour-star accommodation starts at £525pp, all-inclusive, including guiding, activities and transfers, but not flights (about asiatravel.com).
